- (i) PACIFIC (FUGITIVE CRIMINALS SURRENDER) ORDER IN COUNCIL 1914

This Order in Council (S.R. & O. 1914/152 as amended by S.I. 1973/1757) provided for the surrender of fugitive criminals to foreign States with which reciprocal arrangements had been made.

- (ii) EXTRADITION (HIJACKING) ORDER 1971

This Order (S.I. 1971/2102 as amended by S.I. 1977/1237) applied the Extradition Acts 1870 to 1935, as amended, so as to make the offence of hijacking extraditable in the case of States party to the Convention for the Suppression of Unlawful Seizure of Aircraft signed at the Hague on 16th December 1970.

- (iii) EXTRADITION (TOKYO CONVENTION) ORDER 1971

This Order (S.I. 1971/2103 as amended by S.I. 1977/1239) applied the said Extradition Acts as amended by the Tokyo Convention Act 1967 to offences committed on board aircraft in flight registered in States parties to the Tokyo Convention and with whom extradition treaties exist.

(iv) EXTRADITION (PROTECTION OF AIRCRAFT) ORDER 1973

This Order (S.I. 1973/1756 as amended by S.I. 1977/1238) applied the said Acts so as to make extraditable offences and attempts to commit offences against the safety of aircraft created by Part I of the Protection of Aircraft Act 1973 in the case of States party to the Convention for the Suppression of Unlawful Acts against the Safety of Civil Aviation signed at Montreal on 23rd September 1971.

(v) PROTECTION OF AIRCRAFT ACT 1973 (OVERSEAS TERRITORIES) ORDER 1973

This Order (S.I. 1973/1757) extended parts of the Protection of Aircraft Act 1973 to certain territories.
