**EMPLOYMENT ACT (CAP.84)**

ENACTED BY THE PARLIAMENT OF TUVALU

Commencement [1st September 1991]

---

**IN EXERCISE** of the powers conferred by section 119 of the Employment Act the Minister makes the following Regulations —

### **1 Citation and commencement**

These Regulations may be cited as the Employment (Form for Workers Recruiting Licence) Regulations 1991 and shall come into effect on 1st September 1991.

### **2 Form of the workers recruiting licence**

The licence that may be issued by the Commissioner under section 35(1) of the Employment Act shall be in the form prescribed in the schedule.

**SCHEDULE**

**EMPLOYMENT ACT (Cap.84)**

**WORKERS RECRUITING LICENCE**

*(s.35(1) of Cap.84)*

Whereas Mr .....(full name) of .....Company has satisfied me that he is a fit and proper person to recruit workers for overseas employment, and whereas I am satisfied that all necessary measures have been taken for the protection of the recruits beyond the limits of Tuvalu; therefore

I, .....Commissioner of Labour, hereby issue this licence, for recruiting workers from Tuvalu for overseas employment by (name of employer or organisation of employers) subject to the following conditions;

Unless earlier revoked or suspended, this Recruiting Licence will be effective from the date of issue for a period of 12 months.
